

Skip tourist spots, and check out these hidden gems instead.





### Method Art Space, Kala Ghoda & Bandra




One of Mumbai's coolest indie galleries, Method is where art and experimentation collide. Here, the focus is on emerging artists, with everything from graffiti and digital art, to installations, and mixed media works on display. The one in Bandra especially, has an intimate, almost underground vibe, making it feel more like a creative community than a conventional gallery experience. If you're into art that's fresh, bold, and a little rebellious, Method is your spot.

## Tarq, Colaba




Tucked away in a heritage building in Colaba, Tarq feels like one of those quiet escapes from the city's chaos. It's all about contemporary art with an emphasis on sustainability and new media. The curation here is incredibly thoughtful—expect everything from photography and printmaking to conceptual installations. If you love art that feels refined yet boundary-pushing, Tarq is a must-visit.

## Art & Charlie, Bandra



This isn't just a gallery—it's an experience. Art & Charlie is all about making art interactive and accessible, blending exhibitions, live painting, community events, and experimental theatre. One day, you might walk in on a spoken word performance unfolding within an art installation, and the next, watch artists collaborate on a mural in real time. A great example is Rasasvadana, an upcoming performance by Aadya Kalia, where she moves through paintings, blurring the line between performer, artwork, and audience. It's this kind of immersive energy that makes Art & Charlie a must-visit.

#### Project 88, Colaba



Another hidden gem in Colaba, Project 88 is where experimental art meets contemporary art. The artists they showcase often work across disciplines—so you'll see a mix of video art, installations, photography, and even performance pieces. It's a space that feels open-ended like there's no limit to what can be displayed. If you're into cutting-edge, interdisciplinary art, this one's a must.
